

# 2009 Inaugural MPPOA Practical Pistol Match

Corrected Date: 07/26/09 8:00 A.M.-\$15.00 Entry

Please join MPPOA at the Central Ozarks Practical Shooters Range for this event. The range is 30 minutes west of Rolla. Take I-44 to Hwy J (Phelps-Pulaski County Line) then 4.5 miles south to County Road 7640. Turn left (East-the only direction the road goes) onto County Road 7640 and travel  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile. There is a red/orange gate to the left and a large sign. Do your best to be there by 8:00 A.M. There will be a hamburger/hot dog lunch included in the \$15.00 entry fee. There is running water and porta-johns on site. Limited drinks will be available and it WILL be hot so plan accordingly (sun screen, hats, fluids). We should be done before 5:00 P.M.

This match will follow International Defense Pistol Association rules. ([www.idpa.com](http://www.idpa.com)) Most authorized DOC equipment does conform to IDPA rules. Bring a cover garment. Skill level required-Basic familiarity with firearms and be able to safely walk and shoot at the same time. You do not have to be "good"- just safe.

Awards will be certificates and/or plaques.

The match will be 5-6 stages and approximately 100 rounds (minimum if everything goes perfectly) will be needed. Bring at least 200 rounds as you may have to reshoot a stage and there may be a head to head match in the afternoon. You do NOT have to be MODOC authorized to shoot the match... and family members (who are safe gun handlers) are also invited to shoot. To keep the playing field level the following equipment divisions are being utilized.

5 shot revolver – Dept. authorized .38/.357 - Holster and loaders per IDPA Rules.

6 shot revolver - Dept. authorized .38/.357 - Holster and loaders per IDPA Rules

Glock- 22,23,& 27 all shoot in the same division. Magazines may only be loaded with 9 rounds. Holster and pouches per IDPA Rules.

Outlaw Class-Other IDPA allowable guns and gear.

Stages are limited to 18 rounds (if you don't miss).

Don't agonize over the rules. We will have a shooters meeting before the match and square everyone around. The point is to be safe and have fun.

You can share guns but everyone should have their own holster. **Bring eye and hearing protection for everyone in your party.**

If you have guests that are not shooting, lunch is \$5.00 for them.
